Objective

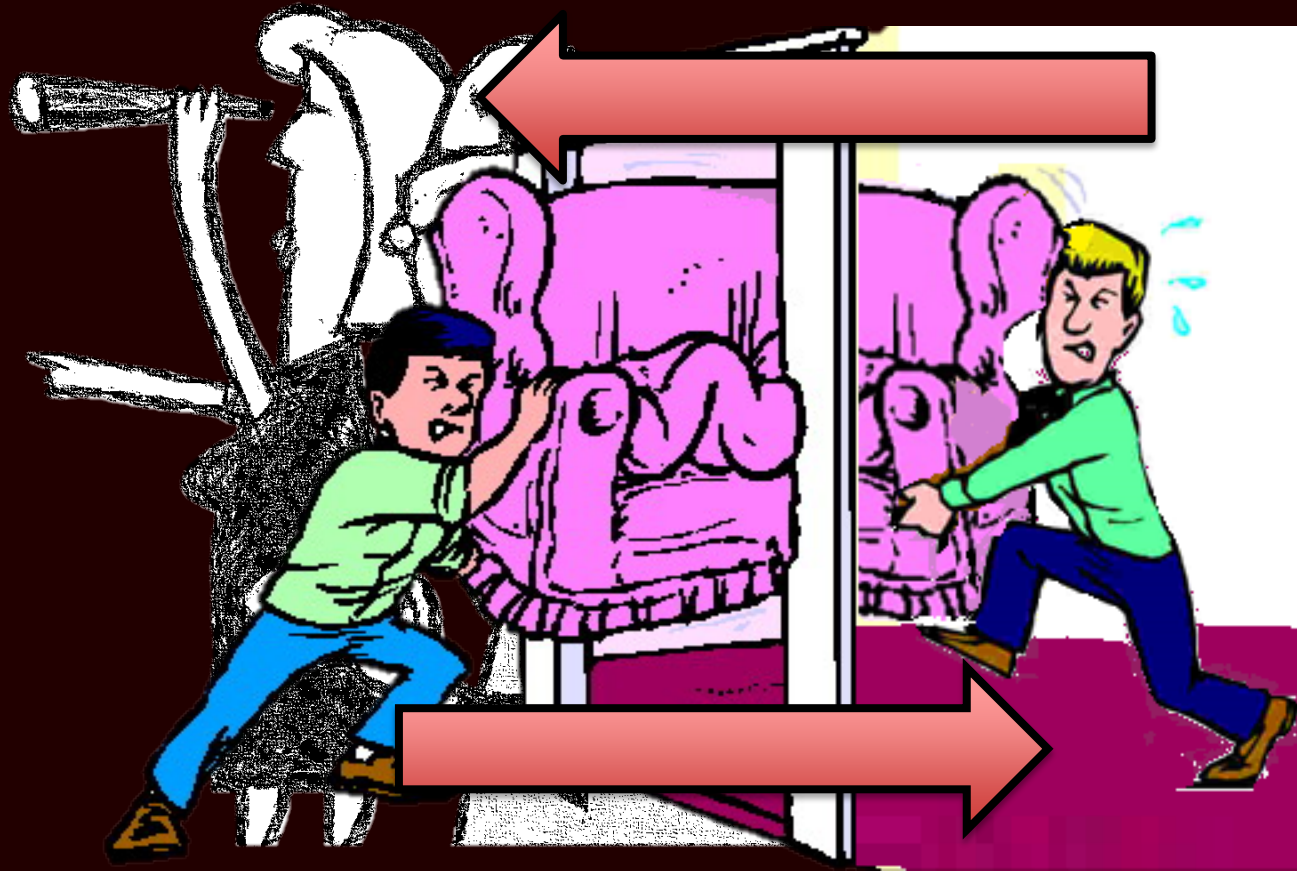
Show the importance of teamwork in accomplishing goals and objectives.

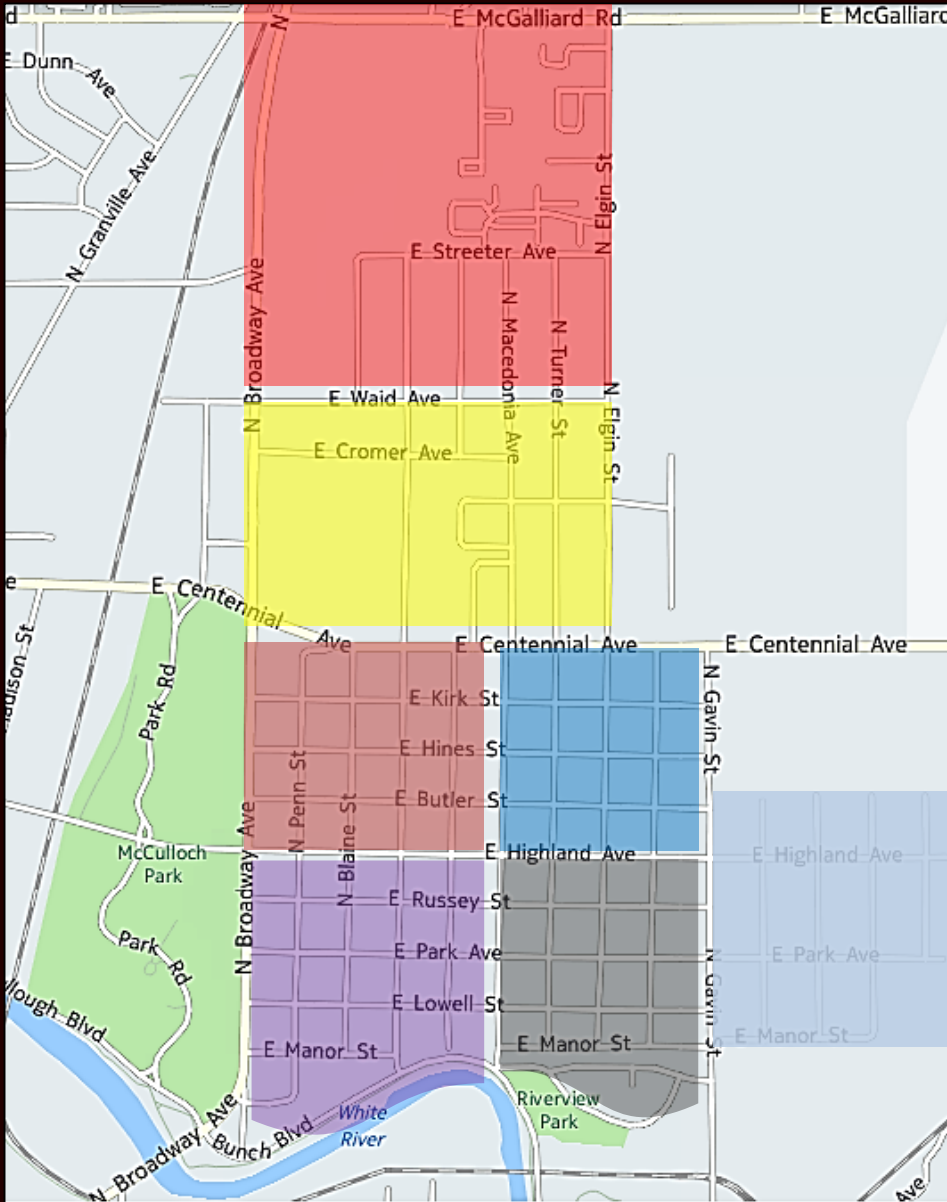
Area Leaders

Share residents ideas problems and concerns (*poorly maintained streets, problems with dogs, safety issues, etc.*) with appropriate Goal Committee.



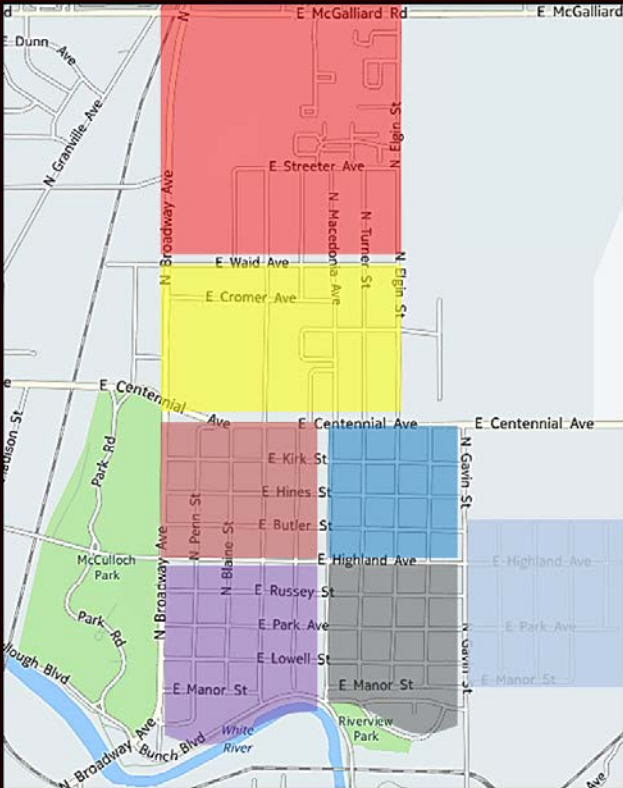

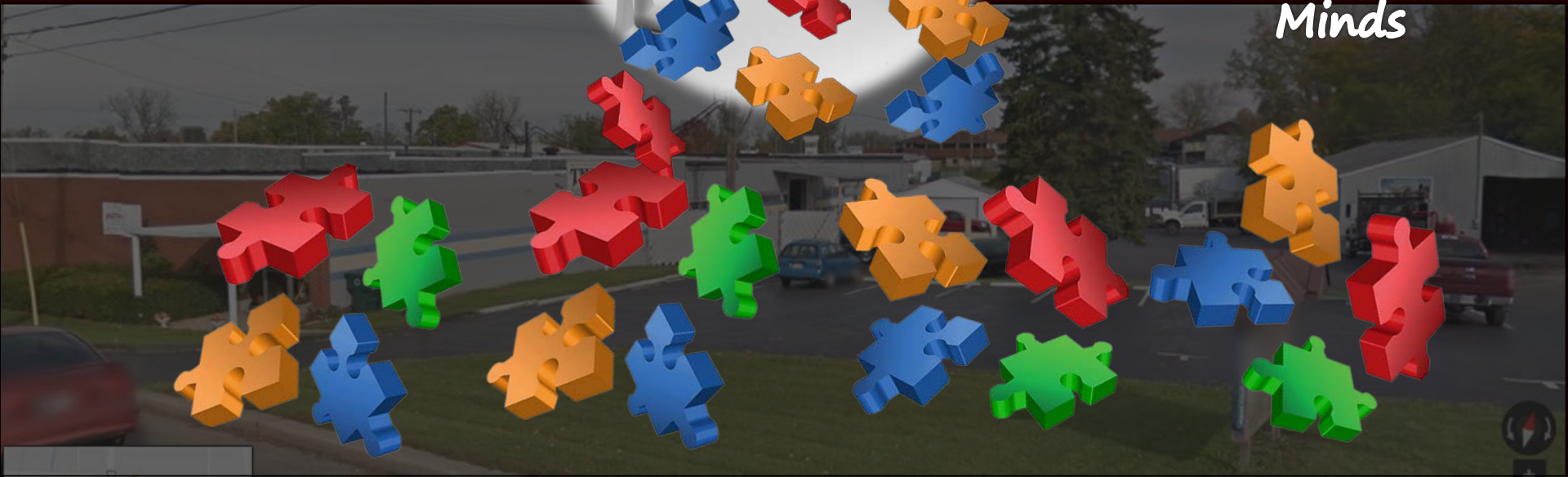
