**Payment Terms:** Customer agrees to comply with the payment terms set forth in this Agreement. The failure to comply with the payment terms may result in the assessment of an interest charge of 18% per annum on the unpaid balance. All dishonored checks shall result in a \$35.00 processing fee. **All debit/credit cards are subject to a 3.5% processing fee for each transaction if using a credit/debit card.** 

**Property Boundaries, Plans and Specifications:** The Customer agrees that it is the Customer's responsibility to provide an accurate plot plan of the property or otherwise confirm the location of the property boundaries. The Customer has reviewed and approved all quotes, plans, specifications and/or drawings depicting the boundary lines of the property and/or the scope of the project. Wasson shall not be responsible for any errors in the boundary lines provided and approved by the Customer.

**Permits and Approvals:** Customer shall be responsible for notifying Wasson of any permits or approvals that are required by any homeowner's association or similar organization.

**Utilities and Concealed Conditions:** Customer acknowledges that Wasson has provided Customer with its Utilities and Concealed Conditions policy, and Customer agrees that such policy is incorporated into this Agreement by reference. Customer agrees that Wasson shall not be responsible for any damage to public and/or private utilities that may result from the improper marking of said utilities.

**Warranties and Plant Care:** Customer acknowledges and agrees that Wasson has provided Customer with a copy of the Plant Installation Warranty, Hardscape Installation Warranty and Landscape Lighting Warranty, each of which is incorporated into this Agreement by reference. Customer further acknowledges that it has received instructions related to the care and maintenance of newly installed plants, hardscape material and/or lighting. Customer agrees that the failure to comply with those instructions shall void any warranty provided by Wasson.

**Watering:** We want your plants to thrive! Make sure you check out the included watering guide as keeping installed plants hydrated as watering is the Client's responsibility. If keeping up with watering is not your forte, Wasson Nursery can provide a watering quote for your plant material as needed.

**Lawns:** Here are the ins and outs of your new lawn: new lawns that are under shade and seed germination are not guaranteed. New sodded lawns are guaranteed to be healthy at the time of installation only. If your new sod is damaged due to pets or wild animals, Wasson Nursery will not incur the cost for replacement as it will be the clients responsibility. The Client will incur all costs for replacement. Watering the Lawn is also the clients responsibility.

**Drainage:** Should the Client's property be the lowest elevation in relation to the surrounding property or buildings, Wasson Nursery reserves the right to retain a Soil Engineer to evaluate and propose drainage solutions. All costs for engineering services, as well as the actual drainage work will need to be taken care of by the Client. Wasson Nursery cannot be held liable for any ponding, pooling or other water drainage issues with the existing grade. When grading a site, we can not alter the existing grade or contouring. Contractually Wasson Nursery will only work on existing grade. Water and drainage problems on property fall under Client responsibility and Wasson Nursery cannot be held liable.

**Grading:** Any settling in lawn due to areas being disturbed from digging, trenching or other yard work of any sort is the Client's responsibility and not that of Wasson Nursery. Ponding or pooling of water on property after grading will not be the responsibility of Wasson Nursery. Irrigation and water leaks are the responsibility of the property owner to report. Wasson Nursery will not be responsible for any water usage on irrigation systems or any water loss due to breaks or damages in the system or improperly programmed clocks. Any extra cost incurred to fix these issues are the Client's responsibility.

**Release of Liability:** Customer acknowledges the foreseeable risks inherent in the completion of the work described in the attached estimates and/or design documents provided to Customer, and hereby releases Wasson, its employees, subcontractors and/or agents from any and all liability for personal injury or property damage resulting from work performed by Wasson, its employees, subcontractors and/or agents, unless such damage or injury is the result of the gross negligence of Wasson, its employees, subcontractors and/or agents.

**Cancellation or Modification:** The Customer may cancel this Agreement at any time before midnight on the third business day after the date this Agreement is signed by Customer and receive a refund of any monies paid. However, Customer acknowledges and agrees that Wasson shall be entitled to assess a reasonable cancellation or modification fee in the event the Customer cancels or modifies this Agreement after materials or plants have been specifically ordered for Customer.

**Permissible Delays:** Wasson shall not be responsible for delays beyond its reasonable control or for any of the following: failure of the issuance of necessary permits within a reasonable length of time; acts of neglect or omission of Customer, Customer's employee(s) or Customer's agent(s); acts of God; stormy or inclement weather; Change Orders approved by Customer; inability to secure material through regular recognized channels; failure of Customer to make payments when due; or delays caused by holidays.

**Third Parties:** Customer understands and agrees that third parties that are not signatories to this Agreement may provide labor, material and/or equipment to complete the work described in the attached estimates and/or the design documents provided to Customer.

**Governing Law/Venue and Attorney's Fees:** This Agreement shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of Indiana. Any proceeding arising from or related to this Agreement shall be exclusively brought and exclusively maintained in the state court of Indiana located in Delaware County and each of the parties hereby consents to and waives any objections to the exclusive personal jurisdiction of, and exclusive venue in, such court in Delaware County. Customer agrees that Customer shall be responsible for payment of Wasson's attorney's fees as a result of any default by Customer.

**Non-waiver:** A waiver of a specific default shall not be a waiver of any other or subsequent default. No failure on the part of the Wasson to exercise, and no delay in exercising, any right or remedy hereunder shall operate as a waiver thereof.

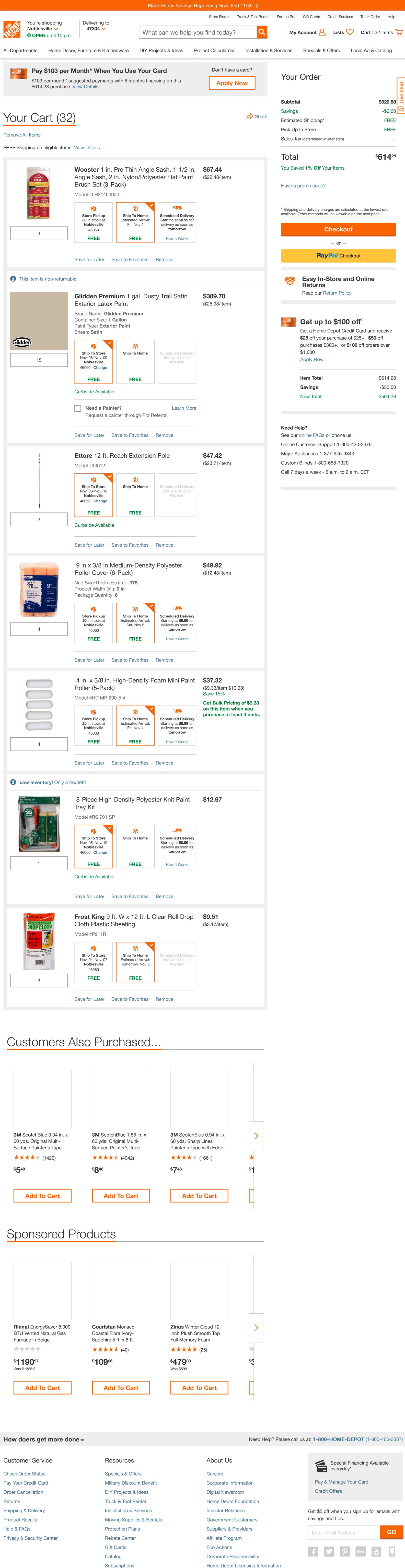
### Payment Terms
