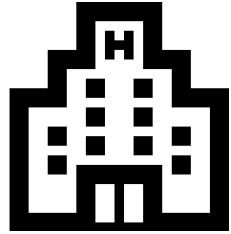

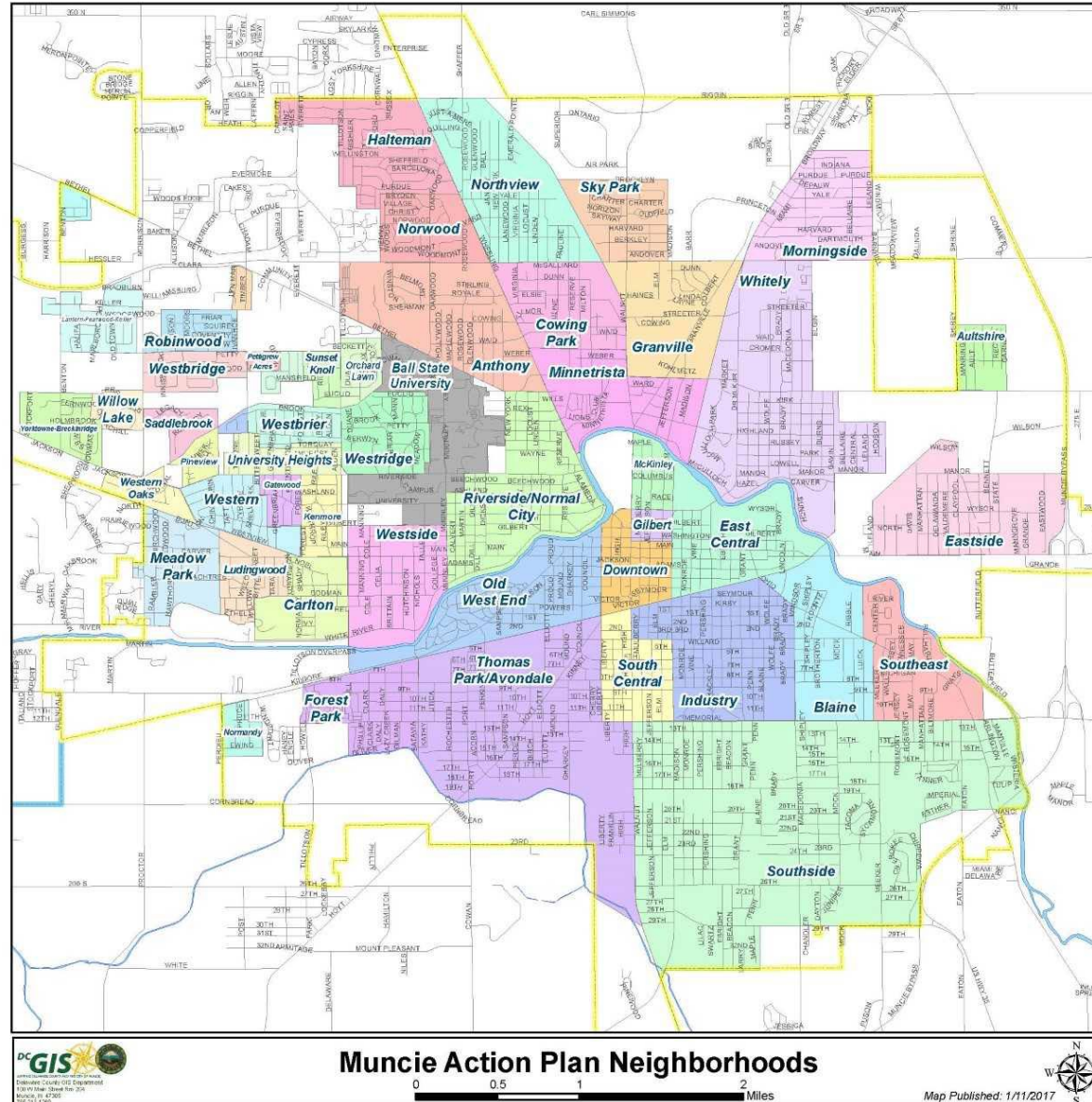

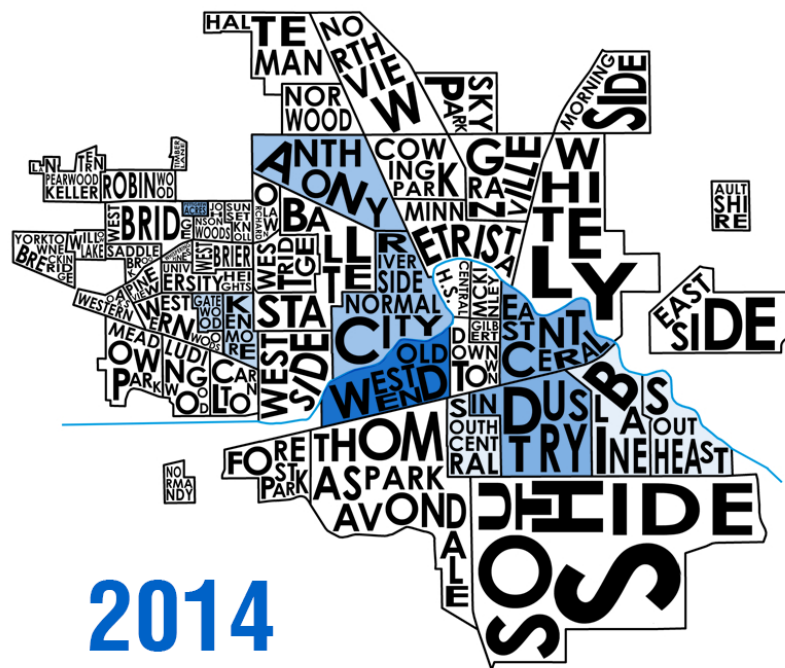


SPECTRUM OF DEVELOPMENT 2014-2022

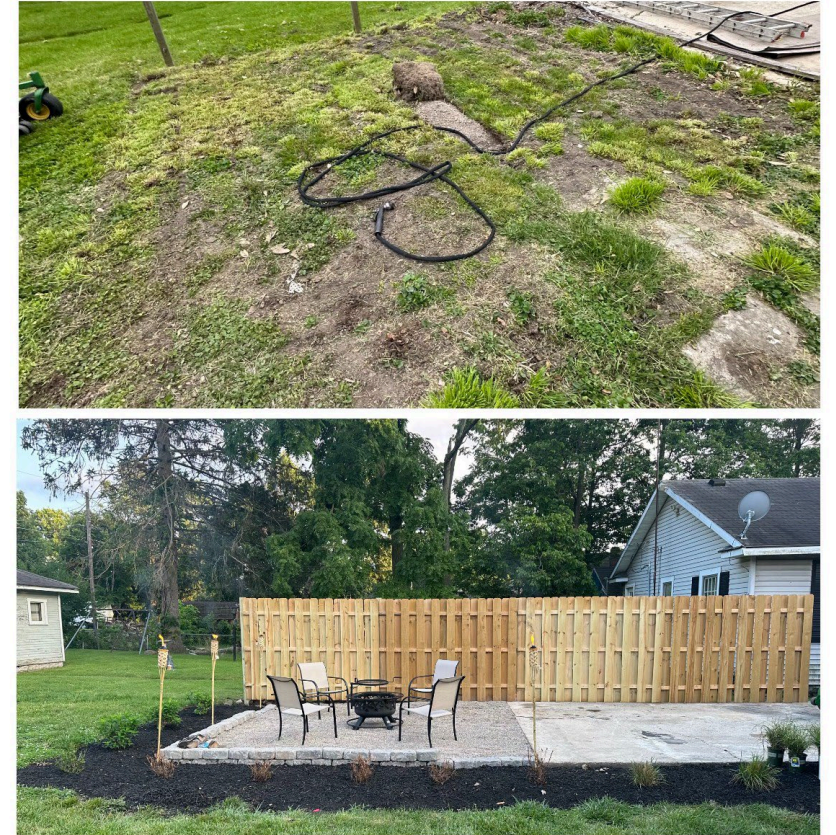

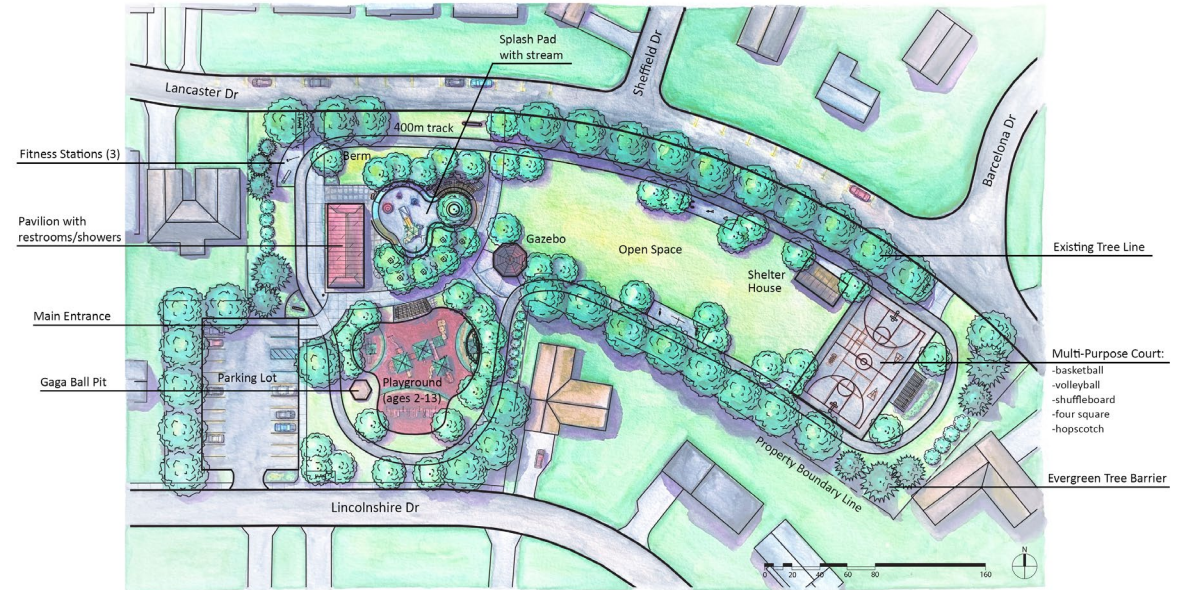

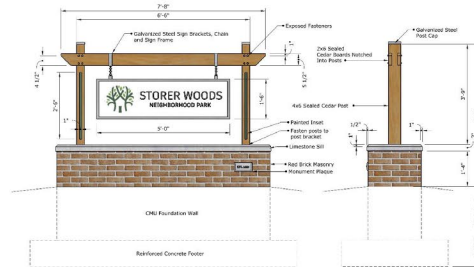
